

“What to Bring” to Bathurst

Please note that lunch and snacks are to be brought for Day 1 (Monday). Please pack in a disposable container/ bag.

GENERAL ITEMS FOR ALL STUDENTS TO BRING

These MUST be **labelled** and carried in one small suitcase/ bag.

Clothing - enough sets of clothes for 3 days away - always ensure you have an extra set 'just in case'.

- T-shirts (no singlets or midriff tops)
- Jeans
- Track suit pants
- Jumpers/ hoodies
- Socks
- Underwear
- Winter pyjamas
- Sun hat
- Beanie
- Gloves
- Raincoat
- Disco clothes
- Sneakers (at least 2 pairs of covered shoes – no thongs)

Other Items

- Linen and / or sleeping bag
- Pillow case
- Towel for showering
- Small back pack for bus and day use
- Toiletries including soap and roll-on deodorant (**DO NOT** bring spray deodorant or body spray)
- Sunscreen
- Water bottle (labelled)
- 2 plastic bags - 1 for dirty clothes & 1 for disgustingly dirty or wet clothes
- Handkerchiefs or small pack of tissues
- Paper and pens/ pencils
- Medication (if necessary)
- Camera (optional)
- Money for souvenirs (no more than \$20)
- Favourite CDs for disco night (labelled – perhaps a 'burnt' copy) (optional)

As Bathurst has a varying climate, which can change rapidly, we suggest that you pack a variety of seasonal clothing, particularly warm clothing such as jackets and tracksuits for winter and cooler nights. Sunhats are essential. To give you an idea please see the following temperature chart:-

	Bathurst Summer	Bathurst winter
Minimum	12.7 oC	1 oC
Maximum	27 oC	12 oC

Items not to be brought to Bathurst. These will be confiscated.
